## A BILL

To clarify that the Upper Missouri River Breaks National Monument does not include within its boundaries any privately owned property, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PRIVATELY OWNED PROPERTY EXCLUDED**  
4 **FROM MONUMENT.**

5 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This section may be cited as the  
6 ‘Upper Missouri River Breaks Boundary Clarification  
7 Act’.

8 (b) PRIVATELY OWNED PROPERTY EXCLUDED FROM  
9 MONUMENT.—

1           (1) PROPERTY CLARIFICATION.—The Upper  
2 Missouri River Breaks National Monument, estab-  
3 lished by Presidential proclamation 7398 on January  
4 17, 2001, shall not include within its boundaries any  
5 privately owned property.

6           (2) MAP.—The Secretary shall keep a map of  
7 the Monument reflecting the boundary clarification  
8 in paragraph (1) on file and available for public in-  
9 spection in the appropriate offices of the Director of  
10 the Bureau of Land Management, Department of  
11 the Interior.
