Mr. THOMPSON of California introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To authorize leases for terms not to exceed 99 years on lands held in trust for the Yurok Tribe and the Hopland Band of Pomo Indians.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. YUROK TRIBE AND HOPLAND BAND INCLUDED**

4 **IN LONG TERM LEASING.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The first section of the Act enti-
6 tled “An Act to authorize the leasing of restricted Indian
7 lands for public, religious, educational, recreational, resi-
8 dential, business, and other purposes requiring the grant
9 of long-term leases”, approved August 9, 1955 (25 U.S.C.
10 415(a)) is amended by inserting “lands held in trust for

1 the Yurok Tribe, lands held in trust for the Hopland Band
2 of Pomo Indians of the Hopland Rancheria,” after “Pueb-
3 lo of Santa Clara,”.

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
5 subsection (a) shall apply to any lease entered into or re-
6 newed after the date of the enactment of this Act.
