3 **SECTION 1. MAJOR HENRY A. COMMISKEY, SR. POST OF-**
4 **FICE BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 115 West Pine Street in Hatties-
7 burg, Mississippi, shall be known and designated as the
8 “Major Henry A. Commiskey, Sr. Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the Major Henry A.
5 Commiskey, Sr. Post Office Building.
