AN ACT

To extend for six months the period for which chapter 12
of title 11 of the United States Code is reenacted.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Family Farmer Bank-
3 ruptcy Relief Act of 2003”.

4 **SEC. 2. SIX-MONTH EXTENSION OF PERIOD FOR WHICH**
5 **CHAPTER 12 OF TITLE 11, UNITED STATES**
6 **CODE, IS REENACTED.**

7 (a) AMENDMENTS.—Section 149 of title I of division
8 C of Public Law 105–277 (11 U.S.C. 1201 note) is
9 amended—

10 (1) by striking “July 1, 2003” each place it ap-
11 pears and inserting “January 1, 2004”; and

12 (2) in subsection (a)—

13 (A) by striking “December 31, 2002” and
14 inserting “June 30, 2003”; and

15 (B) by striking “January 1, 2003” and in-
16 serting “July 1, 2003”.

17 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
18 subsection (a) take effect on July 1, 2003.
