A BILL

To provide for the conveyance to the Utrok Atoll local government of a decommissioned National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration ship.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. UTROK ATOLL RADIOLOGICAL MONITORING**
2 **SUPPORT.**

3 (a) In support of radiological monitoring, rehabilita-
4 tion, and resettlement of Utrok Atoll, whose residents
5 were affected by United States nuclear testing, the Sec-
6 retary of Commerce may convey to the Utrok Atoll local
7 government without consideration, all right, title, and in-
8 terest of the United States in and to a decommissioned
9 National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration ship in
10 operable condition.

11 (b) The Government of the United States shall not
12 be responsible or liable for any maintenance or operation
13 of a vessel conveyed under this section after the date of
14 the delivery of the vessel to Utrok.
