Mr. ENGLISH (for himself and Mr. HAYWORTH) introduced the following bill;
which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain steam generators and certain reactor vessel heads for use in nuclear reactors.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN STEAM GENERATORS, AND CERTAIN**
4 **REACTOR VESSEL HEADS, USED IN NUCLEAR**
5 **FACILITIES.**

6 (a) CERTAIN STEAM GENERATORS.—Heading
7 9902.84.02 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
8 United States is amended by striking “12/31/2006” and
9 inserting “12/31/2012”.

1 (b) CERTAIN REACTOR VESSEL HEADS.—Sub-
 2 chapter II of chapter 99 of the Harmonized Tariff Sched-
 3 ule of the United States is amended by inserting in numer-
 4 ical sequence the following new heading:

5 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by
 7 subsection (b) shall apply to goods entered, or with-
 8 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
 9 January 1, 2003.

10 (2) RETROACTIVE APPLICATION.—Notwith-
 11 standing section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 or
 12 any other provision of law, and subject to paragraph
 13 (4), the entry of any article—

14 (A) that was made on or after January 1,
 15 2003; and

16 (B) to which duty-free treatment would
 17 have applied if the amendment made by sub-
 18 section (b) had been in effect on the date of
 19 such entry,

20 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as if such duty-
 21 free treatment applied, and the Secretary of the

1 Treasury shall refund any duty paid with respect to
2 such entry.

3 (3) ENTRY.—As used in this subsection, the
4 term “entry” includes a withdrawal from warehouse
5 for consumption.

6 (4) REQUESTS.—Liquidation or reliquidation
7 may be made under paragraph (2) with respect to
8 an entry only if a request therefor is filed with the
9 Customs Service, within 180 days after the date of
10 the enactment of this Act, that contains sufficient
11 information to enable the Customs Service—

12 (A) to locate the entry; or

13 (B) to reconstruct the entry if it cannot be
14 located.

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
