## A BILL

To authorize the President to award the Medal of Honor posthumously to Henry Johnson for acts of valor during World War I.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY FOR AWARD OF MEDAL OF HONOR**

4 **TO HENRY JOHNSON.**

5 Notwithstanding the time limitations specified in sec-  
6 tion 3744(b) of title 10, United States Code, or any other  
7 time limitation, the President may award the Medal of  
8 Honor posthumously to Henry Johnson (service number  
9 10-33-48), of Albany, New York, for acts of valor during

1 World War I while a sergeant in the 369th Infantry Regi-  
2 ment of the United States Army.
