**AN ACT**

To provide for the establishment of separate campaign medals to be awarded to members of the uniformed services who participate in Operation Enduring Freedom and to members of the uniformed services who participate in Operation Iraqi Freedom.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT.**

4 The President shall establish a campaign medal spe-  
5 cifically to recognize service by members of the uniformed  
6 services in Operation Enduring Freedom and a separate  
7 campaign medal specifically to recognize service by mem-

1 bers of the uniformed services in Operation Iraqi Free-  
2 dom.

3 **SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY.**

4       Subject to such limitations as may be prescribed by  
5 the President, eligibility for a campaign medal established  
6 pursuant to section 1 shall be set forth in regulations to  
7 be prescribed by the Secretary concerned (as defined in  
8 section 101 of title 10, United States Code). In the case  
9 of regulations prescribed by the Secretaries of the military  
10 departments, the regulations shall be subject to approval  
11 by the Secretary of Defense and shall be uniform through-  
12 out the Department of Defense.
