AN ACT

To amend title XXI of the Social Security Act to make technical corrections with respect to the definition of qualifying State.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS RELATING TO THE**
2 **DEFINITION OF QUALIFYING STATE UNDER**
3 **TITLE XXI OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT.**

4 Effective as if included in the enactment of Public
5 Law 108–74, section 2105(g)(2) of the Social Security
6 Act, as added by section 1(b) of such Act, is amended—

7 (1) by striking “185” the first place it appears
8 and inserting “184”;

9 (2) by inserting “August 1, 1994, or” before
10 “July 1, 1995”; and

11 (3) by inserting before the period at the end the
12 following: “, or, in the case of a State that had a
13 statewide waiver in effect under section 1115 with
14 respect to title XIX that was first implemented on
15 October 1, 1993, had an income eligibility standard
16 under such waiver for children that was at least 185
17 percent of the poverty line and on and after July 1,
18 1998, has an income eligibility standard for children
19 under section 1902(a)(10)(A) or a statewide waiver
20 in effect under section 1115 with respect to title
21 XIX that is at least 185 percent of the poverty
22 line”.
