3 **SECTION 1. WALTER F. EHRRNFELT, JR. POST OFFICE**
4 **BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 15500 Pearl Road in

1 Strongsville, Ohio, shall be known and designated as the
2 “Walter F. Ehrnfelt, Jr. Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the Walter F. Ehrnfelt,
7 Jr. Post Office Building.
