Mr. YOUNG of Alaska introduced the following bill; which was referred to the  
Committee on Energy and Commerce

## A BILL

To extend certain hydro-electric licenses in the State of  
Alaska.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STAY AND REINSTATEMENT OF FERC LICENSE**

4 **NO. 11393.**

5 (a) Upon the request of the licensee for FERC  
6 Project No. 11393, the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-  
7 mission shall issue an order staying the license.

8 (b) Upon the request of the licensee for FERC  
9 Project No. 11393, but not later than 6 years after the  
10 date that the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission re-  
11 ceives written notice that construction of the Swan-Tyee

1 transmission line is completed, the Federal Energy Regu-  
2 latory Commission shall issue an order lifting the stay and  
3 make the effective date of the license the date on which  
4 the stay is lifted.

5 (c) Upon request of the licensee for FERC Project  
6 No. 11393 and notwithstanding the time period specified  
7 in section 13 of the Federal Power Act for the commence-  
8 ment of construction, the Commission shall, after reason-  
9 able notice and in accordance with the good faith, due dili-  
10 gence, and public interest requirements of that section, ex-  
11 tend the time period during which licensee is required to  
12 commence the construction of the project for not more  
13 than one 2-year time period.
