## A BILL

To designate a portion of the United States courthouse located at 2100 Jamieson Avenue, in Alexandria, Virginia, as the “Justin W. Williams United States Attorney’s Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The building and structure de-  
5 scribed in subsection (b) shall be known and designated

1 as the “Justin W. Williams United States Attorney’s  
2 Building”.

3 (b) DESCRIPTION.—The building and structure to be  
4 designated under subsection (a) is that portion of the  
5 United States courthouse located at 2100 Jamieson Ave-  
6 nue, in Alexandria, Virginia (known as the Albert V.  
7 Bryan United States Courthouse), that is attached to the  
8 courthouse main tower structure, described as A-Wing in  
9 the architectural plans, and currently occupied by the Of-  
10 fice of the United States Attorney for the Eastern District  
11 of Virginia, Alexandria Division.

12 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

13 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
14 paper, or other record of the United States to the building  
15 and structure described in section 1(b) shall be deemed  
16 to be a reference to the “Justin W. Williams United States  
17 Attorney’s Building”.

18 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

19 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums  
20 as may be necessary for appropriate identifying designa-  
21 tions to be affixed to the building and structure described  
22 in section 1(b) and for an appropriate plaque reflecting  
23 the designation and honoring Justin W. Williams and his

- 1 service to the Nation to be affixed to or displayed in such
- 2 building and structure.
