3 **SECTION 1. BARBER CONABLE POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 2 West Main Street in Batavia,
6 New York, shall be known and designated as the “Barber
7 Conable Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

- 1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 2 be deemed to be a reference to the Barber Conable Post
- 3 Office Building.
