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## A BILL

To provide an extension of highway, highway safety, motor carrier safety, transit, and other programs funded out of the Highway Trust Fund pending enactment of a law reauthorizing the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Surface Transpor-  
5 tation Extension Act of 2004”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADVANCES.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2(a) of the Surface  
3 Transportation Extension Act of 2003 (23 U.S.C. 104  
4 note; 117 Stat. 1110) is amended by inserting “and the  
5 Surface Transportation Extension Act of 2004” after “as  
6 amended by this Act”.

7 (b) PROGRAMMATIC DISTRIBUTIONS.—

8 (1) ADMINISTRATION OF FUNDS.—Section  
9 2(b)(3) of such Act (117 Stat. 1110) is amended by  
10 striking “the amendment made under subsection  
11 (d)” and inserting “section 1101(c) of the Transpor-  
12 tation Equity Act for the 21st Century”.

10 retary shall distribute the obligation limitation made  
11 available for Federal-aid highways and highway safe-  
12 ty construction programs under the heading ‘(LIMI-  
13 TATION ON OBLIGATIONS)’ under the heading  
14 ‘FEDERAL-AID HIGHWAYS’ in the Transpor-  
15 tation, Treasury, and Independent Agencies Appro-  
16 priations Act, 2004 (division F of Public Law 108–  
17 199) in accordance with section 110 of such Act; ex-  
18 cept that the amount of obligation limitation to be  
19 distributed for such period for each program,  
20 project, and activity specified in sections 110(a)(1),  
21 110(a)(2), 110(a)(4), 110(a)(5), and 110(g) of such  
22 Act shall equal the greater of—

23 “(A) the funding authorized for such pro-  
24 gram, project, or activity in this Act and the  
25 Surface Transportation Extension Act of 2004

1 (including any amendments made by this Act  
2 and such Act); or

3 “(B)  $\frac{9}{12}$  of the funding provided for or  
4 limitation set on such program, project, or ac-  
5 tivity in the Transportation, Treasury, and  
6 Independent Agencies Appropriations Act,  
7 2004.

8 “(2) LIMITATION ON TOTAL AMOUNT OF AU-  
9 THORITY DISTRIBUTED.—The total amount of obli-  
10 gation limitation distributed under paragraph (1) for  
11 the period of October 1, 2003, through June 30,  
12 2004, shall not exceed \$25,232,250,000; except that  
13 this limitation shall not apply to \$479,000,000 in  
14 obligations for minimum guarantee for such period.

15 “(3) TIME PERIOD FOR OBLIGATIONS OF  
16 FUNDS.—A State shall not obligate after June 30,  
17 2004, any funds for any Federal-aid highway pro-  
18 gram project made available by this Act and the  
19 Surface Transportation Extension Act of 2004 (in-  
20 cluding any amendments made by this Act and such  
21 Act), until the date of enactment of a law reauthor-  
22 izing the Federal-aid highway program.

23 “(4) TREATMENT OF OBLIGATIONS.—Any obli-  
24 gation of obligation authority distributed under this  
25 subsection shall be considered to be an obligation for

1 Federal-aid highways and highway safety construc-  
2 tion programs for fiscal year 2004 for the purposes  
3 of the matter under the heading ‘(LIMITATION  
4 ON OBLIGATIONS)’ under the heading ‘FED-  
5 ERAL-AID HIGHWAYS’ in the Transportation,  
6 Treasury, and Independent Agencies Appropriations  
7 Act, 2004.”.

8 **SEC. 3. TRANSFERS OF UNOBLIGATED APPORTIONMENTS.**

9 Section 3 of the Surface Transportation Extension  
10 Act of 2003 (117 Stat. 1112–1113) is amended by adding  
11 at the end the following:

12 “(e) PROHIBITION OF TRANSFERS.—Notwith-  
13 standing any other provision of this section, no funds may  
14 be transferred after February 29, 2004, by a State under  
15 subsection (a)—

16 “(1) from amounts apportioned to the State for  
17 the congestion mitigation and air quality improve-  
18 ment program; and

19 “(2) from amounts apportioned to the State for  
20 the surface transportation program and that are  
21 subject to any of paragraphs (1), (2), and (3)(A)(i)  
22 of section 133(d) of title 23, United States Code.”.
