To authorize an additional permanent judgeship for the
district of Hawaii.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DISTRICT JUDGESHIP FOR THE DISTRICT OF**
4 **HAWAII.**

5 (a) **ADDITIONAL PERMANENT DISTRICT JUDGE-**
6 **SHIP.**—The President shall appoint, by and with the ad-
7 vice and consent of the Senate, 1 additional district judge
8 for the district of Hawaii.

9 (b) **TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—
10 In order that the table under section 133(a) of title 28,
11 United States Code, will reflect the change in the number

1 of permanent judgeships authorized for the district of Ha-
2 waii by subsection (a), such table is amended by striking
3 the item relating to Hawaii and inserting the following:

“Hawaii 4.”.
