3 **SECTION 1. ADDITIONAL TEMPORARY EXTENSION OF AU-**
4 **THORIZATION OF PROGRAMS UNDER THE**
5 **SMALL BUSINESS ACT AND THE SMALL BUSI-**
6 **NESS INVESTMENT ACT OF 1958.**

7 The authorization for any program, authority, or pro-
8 vision, including any pilot program, that was extended

1 through March 15, 2004, by section 1(a) of Public Law
2 108–172 is further extended through May 21, 2004, under
3 the same terms and conditions.

4 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF CERTAIN FEE AUTHORIZATIONS.**

5 Section 503(f) of the Small business Investment Act
6 of 1958 (15 U.S.C. 697(f)) is amended by striking “Octo-
7 ber 1, 2003” and inserting “September 30, 2004”.

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
