4 District of Columbia College Access Act of 1999 (sec.
5 38—2702(i), D.C. Official Code) is amended by striking
6 “each of the five succeeding fiscal years” and inserting
7 “each succeeding fiscal year”.

8 (b) **PRIVATE SCHOOL PROGRAM.**—Section 5(f) of
9 such Act (sec. 38—2704(f), D.C. Official Code) is amend-
10 ed by striking “each of the five succeeding fiscal years”
11 and inserting “each succeeding fiscal year”.
