To amend title 38, United States Code, to extend the authority of the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to make grants to expand or modify existing comprehensive service programs for homeless veterans, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Homeless Veterans As-
5 sistance Reauthorization Act of 2004”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY FOR SECRETARY OF**
2 **VETERANS AFFAIRS TO MAKE GRANTS FOR**
3 **ASSISTANCE TO HOMELESS VETERANS.**

4 Section 2011(a)(2) of title 38, United States Code,
5 is amended by striking “September 30, 2005” and insert-
6 ing “September 30, 2008”.

7 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

8 Section 2013 of title 38, United States Code, is
9 amended—

10 (1) in paragraph (4), by striking
11 “\$75,000,000” and inserting “\$100,000,000”; and

12 (2) by adding at the end the following new
13 paragraphs:

14 “(5) \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 2006.

15 “(6) \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 2007.

16 “(7) \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 2008.”.
