## A BILL

To allow binding arbitration clauses to be included in all contracts affecting the land within the Gila River Indian Community Reservation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BINDING ARBITRATION FOR GILA RIVER IN-**  
4 **DIAN COMMUNITY RESERVATION CON-**  
5 **TRACTS.**

6 (a) AMENDMENTS.—Subsection (f) of the first sec-  
7 tion of the Act entitled “An Act to authorize the leasing  
8 of restricted Indian lands for public, religious, educational,  
9 recreational, residential, business, and other purposes re-

1 quiring the grant of long-term leases”, approved August  
2 9, 1955, (69 Stat. 539; 25 U.S.C. 415(f)) is amended—

3 (1) in the first sentence—

4 (A) by striking “Any lease” and all that  
5 follows through “affecting land” and inserting  
6 “Any contract, including a lease, affecting  
7 land”; and

8 (B) by striking “such lease or contract”  
9 and inserting “such contract”; and

10 (2) in the second sentence, by striking “Such  
11 leases or contracts entered into pursuant to such  
12 Acts” and inserting “Such contracts”.

13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
14 this section shall take effect as if included in “An Act to  
15 amend the Act entitled ‘An Act to authorize the leasing  
16 of restricted Indian lands for public, religious, educational,  
17 recreational, residential, business, and other purposes re-  
18 quiring the grant of long-term leases’, approved August  
19 9, 1955, to provide for binding arbitration clauses in  
20 leases and contracts related to reservation lands of the  
21 Gila River Indian Community”, approved January 23,  
22 2002 (Public Law 107–159).
