## A BILL

To reauthorize the Tropical Forest Conservation Act of 1998 through fiscal year 2007, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDUCTION OF DEBT UNDER THE FOREIGN AS-**  
4 **SISTANCE ACT OF 1961 AND TITLE I OF THE**  
5 **AGRICULTURAL TRADE DEVELOPMENT AND**  
6 **ASSISTANCE ACT OF 1954.**

7        Section 806(d) of the Tropical Forest Conservation  
8 Act of 1998 (22 U.S.C. 2431d(d)) is amended by adding  
9 at the end the following new paragraphs:

10            “(4) \$20,000,000 for fiscal year 2005.

11            “(5) \$25,000,000 for fiscal year 2006.

12            “(6) \$30,000,000 for fiscal year 2007.”.

13 **SEC. 2. USE OF FUNDS TO CONDUCT PROGRAM AUDITS**  
14 **AND EVALUATIONS.**

15        Section 806 of the Tropical Forest Conservation Act  
16 of 1998 (22 U.S.C. 2431d) is amended by adding at the  
17 end the following new subsection:

18            “(e) USE OF FUNDS TO CONDUCT PROGRAM AUDITS  
19 AND EVALUATIONS.—Of the amounts made available to  
20 carry out this part for a fiscal year, \$200,000 is author-  
21 ized to be made available to carry out audits and evalua-  
22 tions of programs under this part, including personnel  
23 costs associated with such audits and evaluations.”.

1 **SEC. 3. AUTHORITY TO ALLOW FOR PAYMENTS OF INTER-**  
2 **EST AND PRINCIPAL IN LOCAL CURRENCIES.**

3 (a) AUTHORITY UNDER THE FOREIGN ASSISTANCE  
4 ACT OF 1961.—Section 806(c) of the Tropical Forest  
5 Conservation Act of 1998 (22 U.S.C. 2431d(c)) is amend-  
6 ed—

7 (1) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by  
8 striking “The following” and inserting “(1) The fol-  
9 lowing”;

10 (2) by redesignating paragraphs (1) and (2) as  
11 subparagraphs (A) and (B), respectively; and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following:

13 “(2) In addition to the application of the provisions  
14 relating to repayment of principal under section 705 of  
15 this Act to the reduction of debt under subsection (a)(1)  
16 (in accordance with paragraph (1)(A) of this subsection),  
17 repayment of principal on a new obligation established  
18 under subsection (b) may be made in the local currency  
19 of the beneficiary country and deposited in the Tropical  
20 Forest Fund of the country in the same manner as the  
21 provisions relating to payment of interest on new obliga-  
22 tions under section 706 of this Act.”.

23 (b) AUTHORITY UNDER TITLE I OF THE AGRICUL-  
24 TURAL TRADE DEVELOPMENT AND ASSISTANCE ACT OF  
25 1954.—Section 807(c) of the Tropical Forest Conserva-  
26 tion Act of 1998 (22 U.S.C. 2431e(c)) is amended—

1           (1) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by  
2           striking “The following” and inserting “(1) The fol-  
3           lowing”;

4           (2) by redesignating paragraphs (1) and (2) as  
5           subparagraphs (A) and (B), respectively; and

6           (3) by adding at the end the following:

7           “(2) In addition to the application of the provisions  
8 relating to repayment of principal under section 605 of  
9 the Agricultural Trade Development and Assistance Act  
10 of 1954 to the reduction of debt under subsection (a)(1)  
11 (in accordance with paragraph (1)(A) of this subsection),  
12 repayment of principal on a new obligation established  
13 under subsection (b) may be made in the local currency  
14 of the beneficiary country and deposited in the Tropical  
15 Forest Fund of the country in the same manner as the  
16 provisions relating to payment of interest on new obliga-  
17 tions under section 606 of such Act.”.

18           (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 810(a) of  
19 the Tropical Forest Conservation Act of 1998 (22 U.S.C.  
20 2431h(a)) is amended by inserting “and principal” after  
21 “interest”.
