2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RELEASE OF UNITED STATES INTERESTS IN**
4 **CERTAIN RAILROAD GRANT LANDS IN TIP-**
5 **TON, CALIFORNIA.**

6 (a) RELEASE OF INTERESTS.—There is hereby re-
7 leased, without consideration, all right, title, and interest

1 of the United States in and to that portion of the property
2 located at 615 North Burnett Road in Tipton, California,
3 which encroaches upon land that, subject to a reversionary
4 interest, was conveyed by the United States pursuant to
5 the Act of July 27, 1866 (14 Stat. 292) to facilitate the
6 construction of transcontinental railroads.

7 (b) INSTRUMENT OF RELEASE.—The Secretary of
8 the Interior shall execute and file in the appropriate office
9 a deed of release, amended deed, or other appropriate in-
10 strument effectuating the release of interests made by sub-
11 section (a).
