3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN PEPPERONCINI PREPARED OR PRE-**
4 **SERVED OTHERWISE THAN BY VINEGAR OR**
5 **ACETIC ACID IN CONCENTRATIONS LESS**
6 **THAN .5%.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is

1 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
 2 new heading:

“	9902.20.07	Pepperoncini, prepared or preserved otherwise than by vinegar or acetic acid in concentrations less than .5% (provided for in subheading 2005.90.97)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2007	”.
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3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 4 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
 5 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
 6 after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
