AN ACT

To amend the Congressional Accountability Act of 1995 to permit members of the Board of Directors of the Office of Compliance to serve for 2 terms.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PERMITTING SECOND TERM FOR BOARD OF DI-**
2 **RECTORS OF OFFICE OF COMPLIANCE.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The second sentence of section
4 301(e)(1) of the Congressional Accountability Act of 1995
5 (2 U.S.C. 1381(e)(1)) is amended to read as follows: “A
6 member of the Board may be reappointed, but no indi-
7 vidual may serve as a member for more than 2 terms.”.

8 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to individuals serv-
10 ing on the Board of Directors of the Office of Compliance
11 on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
