## A BILL

To permanently reenact chapter 12 of title 11 of the United States Code, relating to family farmers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT REENACTMENT OF CHAPTER 12.**

4 (a) REENACTMENT.—Chapter 12 of title 11, United  
5 States Code, as reenacted by section 149 of division C of  
6 the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental  
7 Appropriations Act, 1999 (Public Law 105–277), is reen-  
8 acted.

9 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 302 of the  
10 Bankruptcy, Judges, United States Trustees, and Family

1 Farmer Bankruptcy Act of 1986 (28 U.S.C. 581 note) is  
2 amended by striking subsection (f).

3 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

4 This Act and the amendment made by this Act shall  
5 take effect on January 1, 2004.
