Mr. NEUGEBAUER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Education and the Workforce

A BILL

For the relief of the Big Spring Independent School District.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY FOR GRANTS UNDER RURAL AND**
4 **LOW-INCOME SCHOOL PROGRAM.**

5 The Big Spring Independent School District in the
6 State of Texas shall be eligible to receive a grant under
7 subpart 2 of part B of title VI of the Elementary and
8 Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7351 et seq.;

9 commonly referred to as the “Rural and Low-Income
10 School Program”) for any fiscal year in which the Big
11 Spring Independent School District—

1 (1) meets the eligibility criterion of section
2 6221(b)(1)(A) of such Act (20 U.S.C.
3 7351(b)(1)(A)); and

4 (2) would meet the eligibility criterion of section
5 6221(b)(1)(B) of such Act (20 U.S.C.
6 7351(b)(1)(A)), but for the inclusion of the Federal
7 prison population in the calculation of the school lo-
8 cale codes described in that section.
