To amend a provision relating to privacy officers in the
Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2005.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. Section 522 of the Transportation,
4 Treasury, Independent Agencies, and General Government
5 Appropriations Act, 2005 (division H of the Consolidated
6 Appropriations Act, 2005), is amended to read as follows:

7 “SEC. 522. Each agency shall have a Chief Privacy
8 Officer, who shall assist the agency Chief Information Of-
9 ficer (designated under section 3506 of title 44, United

- 1 States Code) in matters relating to the use, collection, and
- 2 disclosure of personally identifiable information.”.
