AN ACT

For the relief of Durreshahwar Durreshahwar, Nida Hasan,
Asna Hasan, Anum Hasan, and Iqra Hasan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR**
2 **DURRESHAHWAR DURRESHAHWAR, NIDA**
3 **HASAN, ASNA HASAN, ANUM HASAN, AND**
4 **IQRA HASAN.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
6 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
7 Act, Durreshahwar Durreshahwar, Nida Hasan, Asna
8 Hasan, Anum Hasan, and Iqra Hasan shall each be eligi-
9 ble for issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment
10 of status to that of an alien lawfully admitted for perma-
11 nent residence upon filing an application for issuance of
12 an immigrant visa under section 204 of such Act or for
13 adjustment of status to lawful permanent resident.

14 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Durreshahwar
15 Durreshahwar, Nida Hasan, Asna Hasan, Anum Hasan,
16 or Iqra Hasan enters the United States before the filing
17 deadline specified in subsection (c), she shall be considered
18 to have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if other-
19 wise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status under
20 section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of
21 the date of the enactment of this Act.

22 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
23 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
24 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
25 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
26 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

1 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—
2 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
3 idence to Durreshahwar Durreshahwar, Nida Hasan,
4 Asna Hasan, Anum Hasan, and Iqra Hasan, the Secretary
5 of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 5,
6 during the current or next following fiscal year, the total
7 number of immigrant visas that are made available to na-
8 tives of the country of the aliens' birth under section
9 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act or, if appli-
10 cable, the total number of immigrant visas that are made
11 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth
12 under section 202(e) of such Act.

13 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION
14 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural
15 parents, brothers, and sisters of Durreshahwar
16 Durreshahwar, Nida Hasan, Asna Hasan, Anum Hasan,
17 and Iqra Hasan shall not, by virtue of such relationship,
18 be accorded any right, privilege, or status under the Immi-
19 gration and Nationality Act.
