RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 743) to amend the Social Security Act and the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide additional safeguards for Social Security and Supplemental Security Income beneficiaries with representative payees, to enhance program protections, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 743) to

1 amend the Social Security Act and the Internal Revenue
2 Code of 1986 to provide additional safeguards for Social
3 Security and Supplemental Security Income beneficiaries
4 with representative payees, to enhance program protec-
5 tions, and for other purposes. The bill shall be considered
6 as read for amendment. The amendment recommended by
7 the Committee on Ways and Means now printed in the
8 bill shall be considered as adopted. The previous question
9 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,
10 and on any further amendment thereto to final passage
11 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate
12 on the bill, as amended, equally divided and controlled by
13 the chairman and ranking minority member of the Com-
14 mittee on Ways and Means; (2) the further amendment
15 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
16 panying this resolution, if offered by Representative Green
17 of Texas or his designee, which shall be in order without
18 intervention of any point of order, shall be considered as
19 read, and shall be separately debatable for 40 minutes
20 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an
21 opponent; and (3) one motion to recommit with or without
22 instructions.
