Mrs. MYRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 760) to prohibit the procedure commonly known as partial-birth abortion.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 760) to prohibit the procedure commonly known as par-
4 tial-birth abortion. The bill shall be considered as read for
5 amendment. The previous question shall be considered as
6 ordered on the bill and on any amendment thereto to final
7 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour
8 of debate on the bill equally divided and controlled by the

1 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
2 on the Judiciary; (2) the amendment printed in the report
3 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution,
4 if offered by Representative Greenwood of Pennsylvania
5 or his designee, which shall be in order without interven-
6 tion of any point of order, shall be considered as read,
7 and shall be separately debatable for one hour equally di-
8 vided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent;
9 and (3) one motion to recommit with or without instruc-
10 tions.

11 SEC. 2. After passage of H.R. 760, it shall be in order
12 to take from the Speaker's table S. 3 and to consider the
13 Senate bill in the House. It shall be in order to move to
14 strike all after the enacting clause of the Senate bill and
15 to insert in lieu thereof the provisions of H.R. 760 as
16 passed by the House. All points of order against that mo-
17 tion are waived.
