Mr. REYNOLDS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 8) to make the repeal of the estate tax permanent.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 8) to make the repeal of the estate tax permanent. The
4 bill shall be considered as read for amendment. The pre-
5 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
6 and on any amendment thereto to final passage without
7 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the
8 bill equally divided and controlled by the chairman and

1 ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways and
2 Means; (2) the amendment printed in the report of the
3 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution, if of-
4 fered by Representative Pomeroy of North Dakota or his
5 designee, which shall be in order without intervention of
6 any point of order, shall be considered as read, and shall
7 be separately debatable for one hour equally divided and
8 controlled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3) one
9 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
