RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 660) to amend title I of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 to improve access and choice for entrepreneurs with small businesses with respect to medical care for their employees.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 660) to
4 amend title I of the Employee Retirement Income Security

1 Act of 1974 to improve access and choice for entre-
2 preneurs with small businesses with respect to medical
3 care for their employees. The bill shall be considered as
4 read for amendment. The amendment recommended by
5 the Committee on Education and the Workforce now
6 printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted. The pre-
7 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill,
8 as amended, and on any further amendment thereto to
9 final passage without intervening motion except—

10 (1) one hour of debate on the bill, as amended,
11 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
12 ranking minority member of the Committee on Edu-
13 cation and the Workforce;

14 (2) the further amendment printed in the re-
15 port of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
16 resolution, if offered by Representative Kind of Wis-
17 consin or his designee, which shall be in order with-
18 out intervention of any point of order, shall be con-
19 sidered as read, and shall be separately debatable for
20 one hour equally divided and controlled by the pro-
21 ponent and an opponent; and

22 (3) one motion to recommit with or without in-
23 structions.

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
