Ms. PRYCE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2660) making appropriations for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2660) making appropriations for

1 the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services,
2 and Education, and related agencies for the fiscal year
3 ending September 30, 2004, and for other purposes. The
4 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points
5 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-
6 eral debate shall be confined to the bill. After general de-
7 bate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the
8 five-minute rule. All points of order against provisions in
9 the bill are waived except section 217(b). Where points
10 of order are waived against part of a section, points of
11 order against a provision in another part of such section
12 may be made only against such provision and not against
13 the entire section. During consideration of the bill for
14 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole
15 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether
16 the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be
17 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-
18 ignated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amend-
19 ments so printed shall be considered as read. At the con-
20 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
21 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
22 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
23 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
24 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening

- 1 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
- 2 structions.
