Mr. LINDER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2799) making appropriations for the Departments of Commerce, Justice, and State, the Judiciary, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the State of the Union for consid-
5 eration of the bill (H.R. 2799) making appropriations for

1 the Departments of Commerce, Justice, and State, the Ju-
2 diciary, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending
3 September 30, 2004, and for other purposes. The first
4 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of
5 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General
6 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
7 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
8 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-
9 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered
10 for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order
11 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with
12 clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except as follows: the first
13 proviso under the heading “National Telecommunications
14 and Information Administration, Salaries and Expenses”;
15 in section 201, all after “prescribed by the Act”; the final
16 proviso under the heading “Federal Communications
17 Commission, Salaries and Expenses”; the final proviso
18 under the heading “Federal Trade Commission, Salaries
19 and Expenses”; section 603; and section 607(a) and (b).
20 Where points of order are waived against part of a para-
21 graph or section, points of order against a provision in
22 another part of such paragraph or section may be made
23 only against such provision and not against the entire
24 paragraph or section. During consideration of the bill for
25 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole

1 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether
2 the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be
3 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-
4 ignated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amend-
5 ments so printed shall be considered as read. At the con-
6 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
7 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
8 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
9 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
10 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
11 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
12 structions.
