Mr. LINCOLN DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2800) making appropriations for foreign operations, export financing, and related programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the State of the Union for consid-  
5 eration of the bill (H.R. 2800) making appropriations for

1 foreign operations, export financing, and related programs  
2 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, and for  
3 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-  
4 pensed with. All points of order against consideration of  
5 the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to  
6 the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and  
7 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member  
8 of the Committee on Appropriations. After general debate  
9 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-  
10 minute rule. Points of order against provisions in the bill  
11 for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived  
12 except as follows: sections 568(a)(3), 572, and 575. Where  
13 points of order are waived against part of a section, points  
14 of order against a provision in another part of such section  
15 may be made only against such provision and not against  
16 the entire section. During consideration of the bill for  
17 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole  
18 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether  
19 the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be  
20 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-  
21 ignated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amend-  
22 ments so printed shall be considered as read. At the con-  
23 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the  
24 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with  
25 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous

1 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and  
2 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening  
3 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-  
4 structions.
