Mr. LINCOLN DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2443) to authorize appropriations for the Coast Guard for fiscal year 2004, to amend various laws administered by the Coast Guard, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2443) to authorize appropriations

1 for the Coast Guard for fiscal year 2004, to amend various
2 laws administered by the Coast Guard, and for other pur-
3 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.
4 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not
5 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the
6 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
7 on Transportation and Infrastructure. After general de-
8 bate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the
9 five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an
10 original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-
11 minute rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute
12 recommended by the Committee on Transportation and
13 Infrastructure now printed in the bill. The committee
14 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-
15 ered as read. All points of order against the committee
16 amendment in the nature of a substitute are waived. Dur-
17 ing consideration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman
18 of the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in rec-
19 ognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an
20 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of
21 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
22 clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be
23 considered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of
24 the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and re-
25 port the bill to the House with such amendments as may

1 have been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate
2 vote in the House on any amendment adopted in the Com-
3 mittee of the Whole to the bill or to the committee amend-
4 ment in the nature of a substitute. The previous question
5 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
6 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
7 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
