Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (S. 1920) to extend for 6 months the period for which chapter 12 of title 11 of the United States Code is reenacted.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (S. 1920) to extend for 6 months the pe-
6 riod for which chapter 12 of title 11 of the United States
7 Code is reenacted. The first reading of the bill shall be

1 dispensed with. General debate shall be confined to the
2 bill and the amendments made in order by this resolution
3 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
4 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
5 the Committee on the Judiciary. After general debate the
6 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
7 minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original
8 bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute
9 rule an amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting
10 of the text of H.R. 975 as passed by the House. That
11 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-
12 ered as read. All points of order against that amendment
13 in the nature of a substitute are waived. No amendment
14 to that amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be
15 in order except those printed in the report of the Com-
16 mittee on Rules. Each such amendment may be offered
17 only in the order printed in the report, may be offered
18 only by a Member designated in the report, shall be con-
19 sidered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified
20 in the report equally divided and controlled by the pro-
21 ponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-
22 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
23 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the
24 Whole. All points of order against such amendments are
25 waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for

1 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
2 to the House with such amendments as may have been
3 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the
4 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of
5 the Whole to the bill or to the amendment in the nature
6 of a substitute made in order as original text. The previous
7 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
8 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
9 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
10 structions.

11 SEC. 2. If the Senate bill, as amended, is passed, then
12 it shall be in order to move that the House insist on its
13 amendment to S. 1920 and request a conference thereon.
