Mr. REYNOLDS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3752) to promote the development of the emerging commercial human space flight industry, to extend the liability indemnification regime for the commercial space transportation industry, to authorize appropriations for the Office of the Associate Administrator for Commercial Space Transportation, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of

1 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
2 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
3 ation of the bill (H.R. 3752) to promote the development
4 of the emerging commercial human space flight industry,
5 to extend the liability indemnification regime for the com-
6 mercial space transportation industry, to authorize appro-
7 priations for the Office of the Associate Administrator for
8 Commercial Space Transportation, and for other pur-
9 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.
10 Points of order against consideration of the bill for failure
11 to comply with clause 4(a) of rule XIII are waived. Gen-
12 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-
13 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-
14 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
15 Science. After general debate the bill shall be considered
16 for amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill shall
17 be considered as read. No amendment to the bill shall be
18 in order except those printed in the portion of the Con-
19 gressional Record designated for that purpose in clause
20 8 of rule XVIII and except pro forma amendments for
21 the purpose of debate. Each amendment so printed may
22 be offered only by the Member who caused it to be printed
23 or his designee and shall be considered as read. At the
24 conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
25 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with

1 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
2 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
3 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
4 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
5 structions.
