Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for further consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 393) establishing the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2005 and setting forth appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2004 and 2006 through 2009.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for further

1 consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res.
2 393) establishing the congressional budget for the United
3 States Government for fiscal year 2005 and setting forth
4 appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2004 and
5 2006 through 2009. No further general debate shall be
6 in order. The concurrent resolution shall be considered for
7 amendment under the five-minute rule. The concurrent
8 resolution shall be considered as read. No amendment
9 shall be in order except those printed in the report of the
10 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each
11 amendment may be offered only in the order printed in
12 the report, may be offered only by a Member designated
13 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-
14 able for the time specified in the report equally divided
15 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, and
16 shall not be subject to amendment. All points of order
17 against the amendments are waived except that the adop-
18 tion of an amendment in the nature of a substitute shall
19 constitute the conclusion of consideration of the concur-
20 rent resolution for amendment. After the conclusion of
21 consideration of the concurrent resolution for amendment
22 and a final period of general debate, which shall not exceed
23 10 minutes equally divided and controlled by the chairman
24 and ranking minority member of the Committee on the
25 Budget, the Committee shall rise and report the concur-

1 rent resolution to the House with such amendment as may
2 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-
3 ered as ordered on the concurrent resolution and amend-
4 ments thereto to final adoption without intervening motion
5 except amendments offered by the chairman of the Com-
6 mittee on the Budget pursuant to section 305(a)(5) of the
7 Congressional Budget Act of 1974 to achieve mathe-
8 matical consistency. The concurrent resolution shall not
9 be subject to a demand for division of the question of its
10 adoption.
