# H. RES. 580

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3966) to amend title 10, United States Code, and the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to improve the ability of the Department of Defense to establish and maintain Senior Reserve Officer Training Corps units at institutions of higher education, to improve the ability of students to participate in Senior ROTC programs, and to ensure that institutions of higher education provide military recruiters entry to campuses and access to students that is at least equal in quality and scope to that provided to any other employer.

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## RESOLUTION

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at least equal in quality and scope to that provided to any other employer.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order (except those arising under the Congressional Budg-  
4 et Act of 1974) to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
5 3966) to amend title 10, United States Code, and the  
6 Homeland Security Act of 2002 to improve the ability of  
7 the Department of Defense to establish and maintain Sen-  
8 ior Reserve Officer Training Corps units at institutions  
9 of higher education, to improve the ability of students to  
10 participate in Senior ROTC programs, and to ensure that  
11 institutions of higher education provide military recruiters  
12 entry to campuses and access to students that is at least  
13 equal in quality and scope to that provided to any other  
14 employer. The bill shall be considered as read for amend-  
15 ment. The amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-  
16 ommended by the Committee on Armed Services now  
17 printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted. The pre-  
18 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill,  
19 as amended, to final passage without intervening motion  
20 except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill, as amended,  
21 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-  
22 ing minority member of the Committee on Armed Services;  
23 and (2) one motion to recommit with or without instruc-  
24 tions.



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
