RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 581) expressing the sense of the House of Representatives regarding rates of compensation for civilian employees and members of the uniformed services of the United States.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the resolution
3 (H. Res. 581) expressing the sense of the House of Rep-
4 resentatives regarding rates of compensation for civilian
5 employees and members of the uniformed services of the

1 United States. The resolution shall be considered as read
2 for amendment. The previous question shall be considered
3 as ordered on the resolution and preamble to final adop-
4 tion without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of
5 debate equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
6 ranking minority member of the Committee on Govern-
7 ment Reform; and (2) one motion to recommit which may
8 not contain instructions.
