Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4663) to amend part C of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 to extend the discretionary spending limits and pay-as-you-go through fiscal year 2009.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4663) to amend part C of the Bal-

1 anced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985
2 to extend the discretionary spending limits and pay-as-
3 you-go through fiscal year 2009. The first reading of the
4 bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against
5 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall
6 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
7 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
8 nority member of the Committee on the Budget. After
9 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
10 under the five-minute rule. The bill shall be considered
11 as read. All points of order against the bill are waived.
12 No amendment to the bill shall be in order except those
13 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
14 panying this resolution. Each such amendment may be of-
15 fered only in the order printed in the report, may be of-
16 fered only by a Member designated in the report, shall
17 be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time spec-
18 ified in the report equally divided and controlled by the
19 proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-
20 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
21 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the
22 Whole. All points of order against such amendments are
23 waived except that upon adoption of an amendment in the
24 nature of a substitute, only the last amendment printed
25 in the report of the Committee on Rules shall be in order.

1 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-
2 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the
3 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.
4 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
5 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
6 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
7 or without instructions.
