Mr. LINDER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4766) making appropriations for Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4766) making appropriations for

1 Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Adminis-
2 tration, and Related Agencies for the fiscal year ending
3 September 30, 2005, and for other purposes. The first
4 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of
5 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General
6 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
7 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
8 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-
9 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered
10 for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order
11 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with
12 clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except as follows: Begin-
13 ning with the colon on page 3, line 25, through “out” on
14 page 4, line 6; section 717; and section 751. Where points
15 of order are waived against part of a paragraph, points
16 of order against a provision in another part of such para-
17 graph may be made only against such provision and not
18 against the entire paragraph. The amendment printed in
19 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
20 resolution may be offered only by a Member designated
21 in the report and only at the appropriate point in the read-
22 ing of the bill, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-
23 able for the time specified in the report equally divided
24 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, and
25 shall not be subject to amendment. All points of order

1 against that amendment are waived. During consideration
2 of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee
3 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the
4 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has
5 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional
6 Record designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule
7 XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as
8 read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
9 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
10 to the House with such amendments as may have been
11 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
12 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
13 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
14 with or without instructions.
