Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2828) to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to implement water supply technology and infrastructure programs aimed at increasing and diversifying domestic water resources.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 2828) to  
4 authorize the Secretary of the Interior to implement water  
5 supply technology and infrastructure programs aimed at

1 increasing and diversifying domestic water resources. The  
2 bill shall be considered as read for amendment. The  
3 amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by  
4 the Committee on Resources now printed in the bill shall  
5 be considered as adopted. All points of order against the  
6 bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question shall  
7 be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on  
8 any further amendment thereto to final passage without  
9 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the  
10 bill, as amended, equally divided and controlled by the  
11 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee  
12 on Resources; (2) the further amendment in the nature  
13 of a substitute printed in the report of the Committee on  
14 Rules accompanying this resolution, if offered by Rep-  
15 resentative Calvert of California or his designee, which  
16 shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
17 order, shall be considered as read, and shall be separately  
18 debatable for 20 minutes equally divided and controlled  
19 by the proponent and an opponent; and (3) one motion  
20 to recommit with or without instructions.
