IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

Mr. BURTON of Indiana (for himself and Mr. WEXLER) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on International Relations

RESOLUTION

Condemning the terrorist attack in Jakarta, Indonesia, that
occurred on September 9, 2004.

Whereas on September 9, 2004, terrorists attacked hundreds
of innocent civilians, killing at least nine bystanders, in
front of the Australian Embassy in Jakarta, Indonesia;
and

Whereas terrorism must be condemned in the strongest terms
whenever and wherever it occurs: Now, therefore, be it

- 1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—
2 (1) condemns in the strongest possible terms
3 the terrorist attack in Jakarta, Indonesia, that oc-
4 curred on September 9, 2004;

1 (2) expresses its deepest condolences to the
2 families of the individuals murdered in the terrorist
3 attack, expresses its sympathies to the individuals
4 injured in the attack, and conveys its hope for the
5 rapid and complete recovery of all such injured indi-
6 viduals; and

7 (3) urges the United States, Indonesia, Aus-
8 tralia, and all other countries to stand united
9 against terrorism that targets the civilized world and
10 to work together to bring to justice the perpetrators
11 of the terrorist attack in Jakarta, Indonesia.
