RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 106) proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States relating to marriage.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the joint reso-
3 lution (H.J. Res. 106) proposing an amendment to the
4 Constitution of the United States relating to marriage.
5 The joint resolution shall be considered as read for amend-
6 ment. The previous question shall be considered as ordered
7 on the joint resolution to final passage without intervening

1 motion except: (1) two hours and 30 minutes of debate
2 on the joint resolution equally divided and controlled by
3 the Majority Leader and the Minority Leader or their des-
4 ignees; and (2) one motion to recommit.

5 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.J. Res. 106 pursu-
6 ant to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the
7 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-
8 eration of the joint resolution to a time designated by the
9 Speaker.
