RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3193) to restore second amendment rights in the District of Columbia.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 3193) to
4 restore second amendment rights in the District of Colum-
5 bia. The bill shall be considered as read for amendment.
6 The amendment printed in the report of the Committee
7 on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be considered

1 as adopted. The previous question shall be considered as
2 ordered on the bill, as amended, to final passage without
3 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the
4 bill, as amended, equally divided and controlled by the
5 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
6 on Government Reform; and (2) one motion to recommit
7 with or without instructions.
