Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (S. 878) to authorize an additional permanent judgeship in the district of Idaho, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (S. 878) to authorize an additional perma-  
6 nent judgeship in the district of Idaho, and for other pur-  
7 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.

1 All points of order against consideration of the bill are  
2 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and  
3 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled  
4 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the  
5 Committee on the Judiciary. After general debate the bill  
6 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute  
7 rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill  
8 for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule  
9 the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended  
10 by the Committee on the Judiciary now printed in the bill.  
11 The committee amendment in the nature of a substitute  
12 shall be considered as read. All points of order against  
13 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute  
14 are waived. No amendment to the committee amendment  
15 in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except those  
16 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-  
17 panying this resolution. Each such amendment may be of-  
18 fered only in the order printed in the report, may be of-  
19 fered only by a Member designated in the report, shall  
20 be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time spec-  
21 ified in the report equally divided and controlled by the  
22 proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-  
23 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division  
24 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the  
25 Whole. All points of order against such amendments are

1 waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for  
2 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill  
3 to the House with such amendments as may have been  
4 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the  
5 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of  
6 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in  
7 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be  
8 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto  
9 to final passage without intervening motion except one  
10 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
