A BILL

For the relief of Esidronio Arreola-Saucedo, Maria Elena
Cobian Arreola, Nayely Bibiana Arreola, and Cindy Jael
Arreola.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR**
4 **ESIDRONIO ARREOLA-SAUCEDO, MARIA**
5 **ELENA COBIAN ARREOLA, NAYELY BIBIANA**
6 **ARREOLA, AND CINDY Jael ARREOLA.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
8 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
9 Act, Esidronio Arreola-Saucedo, Maria Elena Cobian
10 Arreola, Nayely Bibiana Arreola, and Cindy Jael Arreola

1 shall be eligible for the issuance of immigrant visas or for
2 adjustment of status to that of aliens lawfully admitted
3 for permanent residence upon filing an application for
4 issuance of immigrant visas under section 204 of that Act
5 or for adjustment of status to lawful permanent resident.

6 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Esidronio Arreola-
7 Saucedo, Maria Elena Cobian Arreola, Nayely Bibiana
8 Arreola, and Cindy Jael Arreola enter the United States
9 before the filing deadline specified in subsection (c),
10 Esidronio Arreola-Saucedo, Maria Elena Cobian Arreola,
11 Nayely Bibiana Arreola, and Cindy Jael Arreola shall be
12 considered to have entered and remained lawfully and
13 shall be eligible for adjustment of status under section 245
14 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of
15 enactment of this Act.

16 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
17 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
18 plication for issuance of immigrant visas or the application
19 for adjustment of status are filed with appropriate fees
20 within 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act.

21 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBERS.—
22 Upon the granting of immigrant visas or permanent resi-
23 dence to Esidronio Arreola-Saucedo, Maria Elena Cobian
24 Arreola, Nayely Bibiana Arreola, and Cindy Jael Arreola,
25 the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer to

1 reduce by 4, during the current or next following fiscal
2 year, the total number of immigrant visas that are made
3 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth
4 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
5 Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas
6 that are made available to natives of the country of the
7 aliens' birth under section 202(e) of that Act.
