To extend the final report date and termination date of the National Commission on Terrorist Attacks Upon the United States, to provide additional funding for the Commission, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF NATIONAL COMMISSION ON**
2 **TERRORIST ATTACKS UPON THE UNITED**
3 **STATES.**

4 (a) **FINAL REPORT DATE.**—Subsection (b) of section
5 610 of the Intelligence Authorization Act for Fiscal Year
6 2003 (Public Law 107–306; 6 U.S.C. 101 note; 116 Stat.
7 2413) is amended by striking “18 months” and inserting
8 “20 months”.

9 (b) **TERMINATION DATE.**—Subsection (c) of that sec-
10 tion is amended—

11 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “60 days” and
12 inserting “30 days”; and

13 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “60-day pe-
14 riod” and inserting “30-day period”.

15 (c) **ADDITIONAL FUNDING.**—Section 611 of that Act
16 (6 U.S.C. 101 note; 116 Stat. 2413) is amended—

17 (1) by redesignating subsection (b) as sub-
18 section (c);

19 (2) by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-
20 lowing new subsection (b):

21 “(b) **ADDITIONAL FUNDING.**—In addition to the
22 amounts made available to the Commission under sub-
23 section (a) and under chapter 2 of title II of the Emer-
24 gency Wartime Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2003
25 (Public Law 108–11; 117 Stat. 591), of the amounts ap-
26 propriated for the programs and activities of the Federal

1 Government for fiscal year 2004 that remain available for
2 obligation, not more than \$1,000,000 shall be available for
3 transfer to the Commission for purposes of the activities
4 of the Commission under this title.”; and

5 (3) in subsection (c), as so redesignated, by
6 striking “subsection (a)” and inserting “this sec-
7 tion”.
