1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. OSCAR SCOTT WOODY POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5 Postal Service located at 223 South Main Street in

1 Roxboro, North Carolina, shall be known and designated  
2 as the “Oscar Scott Woody Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
6 be deemed to be a reference to the Oscar Scott Woody  
7 Post Office Building.
